At the owners' meeting in February 2015 we discussed several other improvements to be made in 2015 (see minutes and previous messages).

In this message the Board will inform you about the progress made and to be made the next month.

Pool surround

A long headed wish is to improve the surface around the pool. As we wrote earlier this is going to take



place in November this year.

The Board selected tiles at Gartish Tegelwerk of the type Travertine Classic (out grey). It is a beautiful grey tile (15x30 cm) with the pleasant quality that it does not feel hot at your feet, even in full sun.

The tiles will be placed in 'french pattern' on top of the now present concrete (which will not be removed). The acreage is 225 m².

Also the coping (the edging of

the pool) will be renewed. Together with application of the tiles and coping some repair will be carried out at the small white and blue tiles inside the pool. The work will be carried out by Jansen. Though the concrete will not be removed we hope you do understand some **noise disturbance** is inevitable. It is also necessary to empty the pool. **During November the swimming pool will be out of order.**

Pedestrian door in the wall at the street side



As Bernd Gabold already e-mailed you all the pedestrian door in the wall at the street side has been installed. The wall has been painted in the colours of the resort.

The work is not completely finished. On the top there will be iron strips to prevent burglars climbing over. And every owner will receive two keys of the door. As soon as enough keys are available you will be informed.

Making the wall at the street side higher

Another part of the job to be done is to make the wall at the street side higher. Most of the brickwork has been done and the row of iron spikes have been placed on top. Several additional works will be

carried out the next weeks. Bougainvillea's will be planted later.



Meter bunkers and planters

The meter bunkers are equipped with metal doors and have been painted. This work is completed. The planters at the parking lot have been installed. Flowers and plants will be put in by Johan.

Lighting

Several remarks have been made about not functioning (security) lights. The condition of the electricity works at LOR appears to be very poor. The Board prepares a plan to improve the lighting at the resort.

Security

Unfortunately burglars don't stop to visit our resort. Though the damage and booty do not seem to be very big, this is a situation that has to be fought. The Board will present additional measures soon.

Security analysis also shows that a lot of units are not closed properly. Please inform your guests about the necessity to close doors and windows properly while they are away and during the night time.
