1. Membership and vote

Per type of building: 1 member *(2 owners or more together are 1 member)*

* a bungalow carries the right to cast 4 votes

* an apartment carries the right to cast 2 votes

* a studio carries the right to cast 1 vote

If a member owns more than one bungalow, apartment or studio than he / she still counts as one member. LOR consists of 33 buildings and per 1-12-2015 27 members
NB the number of votes is always determined by the property and not by the member or number of members.

One (1) member does have the total number of votes attached to the building he / she owns.

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2. Quorum = based on number of members

In order for the General Membership Meeting to adopt resolutions in the first place at all times the number of members present is important: the so-called quorum requirement. The quorum is: 1/3 of the total number of members of 27 = 9 members.

3. Adopting resolutions = based on the number of votes cast

If the quorum requirement has been complied with, the votes present are counted. This is the number of votes per member present. This will allow calculation of the majority ($1/2 + 1$)

4. Resolutions by e-mail

Resolutions may be adopted by e-mail if the following conditions have been complied with:

- a) all members must agree with a vote by e-mail, fax or otherwise; and
- b) all members must have communicated by e-mail, fax or otherwise, or else have voted; and
- c) all members must vote in favor. Abstentions are also permitted and shall be considered as "vote in favor". In case of a vote against, the motion will be rejected.

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
